—a residential family home with care directed to the individual child according to his/her personal needs;

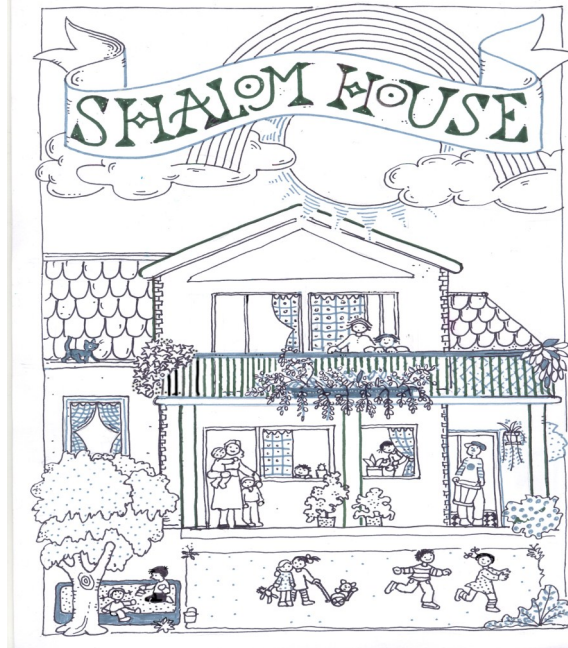

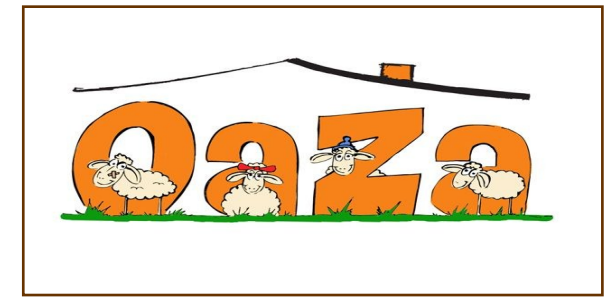

“Casa Shalom”

For nearly 15 years, Oaza has been providing residential services in the form of family homes for the children placed under its care.



New location for Casa Shalom

This kind of setting seeks to provide for the basic physical, emotional, educational and social needs of the children. Oaza becomes their family for the duration of their placement. Children are encouraged to study, practice sports, play instruments, attend community projects as well as being trained for independent living. The current ‘family home’ is named “Casa Shalom” and can accommodate 6 children.



Educational Centre : “ Children’s Oasis”



Oaza seeks to assist families in the local community through early intervention. Our newest project is the development of an **Educational Center**

to include:

- an **after-school program** for children 7 to 11yrs old from socially and economically disadvantaged families. **24 children** come to us after school hours, receive a nutritious meal, do their homework and have access to extracurricular educational activities such as arts and crafts, English, music and IT lessons.



- a **daycare program** to provide day time care for up to 20 very young children.



“A chance for every child”



Our philosophy is that every child deserves a family. Oaza has tried to be a substitute “family” for 15 years with some success. However, helping the children be with their natural families

where possible, or with foster families, has become our goal and purpose in recent years. Oaza supports the children in their families for a period of 1 year or more. Our specialists visit regularly - bringing food and counsel to the family as a whole. Once a year, we invite all the children to join us for the
